This is Pim.










Sometimes his friends would come home with him after school and they would play with his toys and have tea together. It was such fun!

He can't go to school because of the Coronavirus. It makes people very poorly and lots of people have gone to hospital. Everyone has to stay at home to stay safe.










































'Pim' is a free resource for parents and teachers.
